A \$1.4 million, 15,000 square foot renovation for the new culinary school that includes three commercial kitchens and support areas.

In 2001, A. Martini & Co. renovated a 120,000 square foot, ten-story building into the new home for the Art Institute of Pittsburgh. They returned to the building in June, 2002 to complete a second project - renovating a 15,000 square foot area on the 9th floor into a teaching facility for the Institute's culinary school. This project included three fully functioning commercial kitchens: a 1,596 square foot “a la carte” kitchen, a 1,150 square foot skills kitchen, and a 1,250 square foot bakery and pastry kitchen. This project also included storage rooms, locker rooms, restrooms, faculty work areas, and offices. The construction, which was completed in four months, was finished without the use of any additional staging areas and without disruption to any other areas in the building.
