Lidia Bastianich, a world-renowned chef, modeled Lidia's Pittsburgh after her restaurants in New York and Kansas City. Her restaurants are known as much for their design as for her signature Northern Italian cuisine. The Pittsburgh restaurant features: hand-blown glass chandeliers; pre-fabricated, custom-designed bar; and custom woodwork and light fixtures.

Due to this sophisticated design and the custom elements of the project, communication and coordination of the team was critical. A. Martini & Co. managed the work of 25 sub-contractors, and also strived to communicate effectively with the developer, out-of-town design architect, architect of record, and out-of-town owner. These efforts enabled them to meet the aggressive four-month schedule so that the restaurant was completed before opening night.
